Classic Cuts



The Skin Fade

Clean, sharp and modern.

A fade down to the skin at the sides and back with blended length on top. Works well with textured crops, pompadours or slick backs.

Best for: Sharp, defined style that stays fresh for weeks.

Tip: Ask Jonny to tailor the fade height to suit your head shape.



The Taper Fade

Timeless and versatile.

A gradual fade that keeps length near the neckline and ears for a softer, classic finish. Pairs well with side parts or comb-overs.

Best for: A clean-cut professional look with easy maintenance.

Tip: Style with a matte clay for natural hold.

Textured & Modern Styles



The Crop

Effortlessly stylish.

A short, choppy cut with texture and fringe. Perfect for a relaxed, modern vibe.

Best for: Guys wanting low fuss and maximum texture.

Tip: Use sea salt spray to enhance natural texture.



The Pompadour

Bold and classic.

Longer on top with volume and height, faded or tapered sides. Think vintage meets modern.

Best for: Thick hair with natural volume.

Tip: Blow dry with a round brush for lift, finish with a strong pomade.

The Bro Flow

Relaxed and natural.

Medium-length cut brushed back with natural flow and movement.

Best for: Wavy or straight hair that sits well when grown out.

Tip: Use a lightweight cream to keep it tidy but free-flowing.



The Modern Mullet

Retro but fresh.

Short at the front and sides, longer at the back — revamped for a bold statement.

Best for: Guys ready to stand out.

Tip: Keep the fade sharp for a modern twist.
